

## Faculty Position at the Osaka School of International Public Policy, Osaka University

Outline	Osaka School of International Public Policy, Osaka University invites applications for a faculty position in the field of Global Studies.
1. Position	Professor (tenured), Associate Professor or Associate Professor (Lectuer) (tenured or tenure-track)  *The position and the responsibilities assigned to the successful applicant will be decided based on the applicant's qualifications.

7. Qualifications	<ol> <li>A doctoral degree (doctorate or Ph.D.) must be obtained by the start date of the appointment.</li> <li>Proficiency in English.</li> <li>A working knowledge of Japanese will be one of the conditions for acquiring tenure.</li> </ol>
	We seek a scholar who holds a doctoral degree in the humanities or social sciences, broadly defined, by the time of appointment and conducts policy-relevant research on global issues. We welcome applicants across all disciplines and with any regional expertise, but are particularly interested in those whose research and teaching focus on one or more of the following fields: gender, environment, race and ethnicity, migration, education, public health, and human security. Relevant career experience at international organizations or NGOs is preferred but not required.
8. Starting Date	A mutually agreed upon date on or after April 1 2024
9. Term of Employment	No fixed term for a tenured position (until the end of the fiscal year at the age of 65). For a tenure-track position, the term of employment is four years. A tenure evaluation will be conducted by the end of the term of employment, and if the applicant passes the evaluation, the applicant becomes an employee with no fixed term of employment. If evaluated as necessary, OSIPP may renew the term of employment for up to three years (as a general rule, only once). If the applicant passes the re-evaluation by the end of the new term of employment, the applicant becomes an employee with no fixed term of employment.
