

Application Guideline for the Double Degree Program with the Graduate School of International Studies, Yonsei University

We are excited to present an opportunity for the Dual Degree Program with the Graduate School of International Studies, Yonsei University, located in the center of Seoul, South Korea. GSIS is the leading public policy school in South Korea as well as in East Asia, offering a wide variety of courses in English, Korean, Japanese, and Chinese and boasting an extremely diverse student body. You will spend the first year at OSIPP and second year at GSIS (and another semester at OSIPP for thesis writing) to earn the Master of International Public Policy from OSIPP and the Master of Global Affairs & Policy (International Cooperation Major) from GSIS, while paying the tuition and other fees only to OSIPP.

- 2. Eligibility
- Must be a full-time student at OSIPP
- At least one semester spent at OSIPP at the time of nomination
- TOEFL 100 or equivalent preferred
- 4. Nomination Deadline: October 1
- 5. Semesters at GSIS

Spring Semester: March-June Fall Semester: September- December

6. Enrollment Model

Year One: earn 22 credits at OSIPP (11 courses)

Year Two: earn 24 credits at GSIS (8 courses) and 4 credits at OSIPP (thesis advising I and II) Year Three (one semester only): finish the Master Thesis at OSIPP

Note:

— Most courses at GSIS are three-credit courses.

— You will need to complete 32 credits plus a Master Thesis at OSIPP and 48 credits without a Master Thesis at GSIS. 26 credits at OSIPP (11 courses and thesis advising I and II) will be converted to 24 credits at GSIS. 24 credits at GSIS will be converted to 10 credits at OSIPP.

— Completing everything in two years (four semesters) is not impossible, but a fifth semester at OSIPP is expected.

7. Application

To be considered for nomination, please send the following minus the letter of recommendation to Kazushi Minami (<u>minami@osipp.osaka-u.ac.jp</u>) before **October 1**. Address all inquiries to the same email address. The final nominee will be decided by mid-October. Once nominated, the nominee will be instructed to submit the following to GSIS by **October 31**.

- 1. Transcript
- 2. Research Plan (500 words max.)
- 3. Curriculum Vitae
- 4. Letter of Recommendation
- 5. Proof of English Proficiency (for non-native speakers only)
